

The Nairobi T T I Students' Governing Council

The institute has established a structured student organization known as the NTTI Student's Governing Council whose purpose is to promote the Academic and General Welfare of the students of Nairobi Technical Training Institute.

The NTTI SGC is composed of all the elected Class Representatives plus any other member co-opted by the SGC steering committee in a given calendar year.

The Class Reps from each department meet under the supervision of the HOD to elect one representative to the Executive Committee.

The members of the executive committee elect each other to the seven positions of the office bearers under the supervision of the office of the dean of students and members of the steering committee
